

12 Consecutive Years of Best in State MCA Performance

Westonka students scored in the top 10 districts in the state on 2014 MCAs. Overall, Westonka is ranked #5 in the state in reading and #8 in the state in math.

- Grade 3 is ranked Top 10 in state in reading, #5 in state in math
- Grade 4 is #4 in state in reading
- Grade 5 is #1 in state in reading, #7 in math and #9 in science
- Grade 6 is #7 in state in reading, #2 in math
- Grade 7 is #2 in state in reading, #5 in math
- Grade 8 is Top 10 in state in science
- Grade 10 is #7 in state in reading
- Grade 11 is above state average in math

National Blue Ribbon Awards

Hilltop Primary School was selected as a National Blue Ribbon winner for 2012—one of only seven schools in Minnesota. Shirley Hills Primary School is a 2008 Blue Ribbon winner.

'Best High School' Recognitions

Mound Westonka High School is recognized as one of the best high schools in the country. MWHS is ranked No. 104 in the nation on Newsweek's list of "America's Top 500 High Schools" and earned a "Best High Schools" Silver Award from U.S. News & World Report.

AP District Honor Roll

Westonka was one of only 11 Minnesota districts named to the College Board's 2012 AP® District Honor Roll for increasing access to AP Exams as well as the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher (usually the minimum to earn college credit).
