

Lakeview Legacy Park

- Established 2015 by partnership between Source Land Capital and Citizens for Lakeview Preservation (non-profit).
- Protected by conservation easement as a passive park, focused on ecology, native species, education, and history.
- Opportunities for learning, meeting neighbors, enjoying wildlife.

2016-2017 Activities

- 50 + native trees (15 species) planted
- Native Plant Garden and Lepidoptera (butterfly) habitat constructed
- Fountain placed in small pond
- First group of native shrubs, stone benches and educational signs Installed.



2017-2018 Plans

- Construction of Gazebo (Learning Shelter)

 - Lakeview Golf Course tribute display
 - Early settler historic area
 - Additional trees and plantings
